

NATO Military Police COE Prepares for Fast Approaching Start - Joint Force Training Centre

The second Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) Conference for the NATO Military Police Centre of Excellence (NATO MP COE) has just ended at the Joint Force Training Centre. Again, the JFTC supported the COE that soon will reinforce and increase the Bydgoszcz NATO family. The Conference took place between 17 and 21 September. The NATO MP COE's work inauguration is planned for the beginning of 2013.

As the launch of the COE is approaching fast, participants of the Conference, altogether 34 specialists representing 12 countries, focused on the most important issues concerning mission, activities and shape of the Centre. They talked about the Concept and Memoranda of Understanding of the NATO MP COE as well as its manning and Programme of Work. The participants also had an opportunity to discuss their thoughts with Major General Anatol Wojtan, the Deputy Chief of the General Staff of the Polish Armed Forces and with Major General Mirosław Rozmus, the Commander of the Polish Military Police, who took part in the opening phase of the event. The outcome of the Conference gave an overview on the current stage of preparations and defined what requires further actions.
