Discussions on the support the Polish Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MFA) can provide to the Joint Force Training Centre, the Centre's Peacetime Establishment (PE) and the Coalition Warrior Interoperability Exercise (CWIX) 2013 marked the visit that Mr. Bogusław Winid, the Undersecretary of State in the Polish MFA, paid to the JFTC. The visit took place on 11 December.

Minister Winid met with the JFTC Command Group, including the Centre's Commander, Major General Pavel Macko, to talk over current issues that bind the JFTC and the Polish MFA. As the JFTC is now transiting to its new PE, the JFTC guest declared that the MFA would encourage nations to fill their posts at the Centre's structure soon. Minister Winid was also very interested in issues concerning the CWIX 2013, planned for the middle of the next year. The exercise will be the biggest JFTC event in 2013 and will certainly draw attention of the whole Alliance and collaborative nations. The Polish MFA expressed its willingness to support the JFTC in promoting the event at the highest possible level.

Many other issues related to the current needs the JFTC has were discussed during the meeting. Minister Winid ensured the Commander that the MFA would continue supporting the JFTC's activities and the Centre itself. Both parties agreed on future ways of mutual cooperation.
