In Bydgoszcz every January is marked with two significant anniversaries. On 20 January the Joint Force Training Centre's Host City celebrates the Anniversary of the Return of Bydgoszcz to the Motherland in 1920 and four days later the citizens of Bydgoszcz commemorate the Anniversary of the Liberation of Bydgoszcz from German Occupation in 1945. Traditionally the JFTC representations join the authorities of the City during the municipal ceremonies. So it was this year.

On 20 January the JFTC Commander, Major General Pavel Macko, together with the Mayor of Bydgoszcz, Mr. Rafał Bruski, the Chairman of the City Council, Mr. Roman Jasiakiewicz, representatives of regional authorities as well as local military and police units, laid a wreath next to the Liberty Monument at the Liberty Square. On 24 January, the JFTC Deputy Commander, Brigadier General Grzegorz Buszka, together with the Voivode of Kujawsko-Pomorskie Province, Mrs. Ewa Mes, the Deputy Mayor of Bydgoszcz, Mr. Jan Szopiński and other military, veteran and civil delegations, paid tribute to the fallen during the Second World War and laid a wreath at the monument commemorating soldiers who lost their lives during the war.
