



With the end of the ISAF Regional Command North Training Event (RC N TE) 13-01, the Joint Force Training Centre completed its mission for 2012. The RC N TE was held at the Centre between 26 November and 12 December. It was the third training of this kind conducted by the JFTC this year. This time the RC N TE was an integral part of a wider project - the Unified Endeavour 13-1.

Close to 200 soldiers of the ISAF RC N Headquarters' next rotation were preparing in Bydgoszcz for their deployment to Afghanistan. They were trained and supported by more than 300 soldiers and civilians, including Subject Matter Experts, Real Life Support and representatives of the Afghan National Security Forces (ANSF). Again, a remarkable work was done by the NATO Communication and Information Systems Agency Squadron Bydgoszcz that took care of the CIS part of the event. Altogether, 500 participants from 28 NATO and Partnership for Peace Nations worked hand in hand for a success of the training and their future challenging mission.
